

Pursuant to Articles 4.2, 4.7. and 7 of the Law on Transmission of Electric Power, Regulator and System Operator of Bosnia and Herzegovina (Official Gazette of BiH, 7/02, 13/03, 76/09 and 1/11), Article 36 of the Rule of Practice and Procedure of the State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Official Gazette of BiH, 2/05) and Article 51, paragraph 1, point a) of the Licensing Rule - Consolidated Version (Official Gazette of BiH, 63/16), acting upon the request of legal person "Koksara" d.o.o., Lukavac of 30 April 2025, at its session held on 12 May 2023 the State Electricity Regulatory Commission, passed a

DECISION

ON SUSPENSION OF TEMPORARY LICENCE FOR PERFORMANCE OF INTERNATIONAL ELECTRICITY TRADING ACTIVITY

1. At the request of the licensee, the temporary license for performance of the international electricity trading activity, registration number 05-28-12-302-20/24, issued to legal person "Koksara" d.o.o., Lukavac shall be suspended.
2. The licence referred to in point 1 of this decision shall be suspended in the period from 13 May 2025 to 12 May 2026.
3. This decision shall come into force on the day of adoption and the operative part thereof shall be published in the "Official Gazette of BiH" and the official gazettes of the Entities.

Statement of rationale

On 30 April 2025, legal person "Koksara" d.o.o., Lukavac (hereinafter: the applicant) filed with the State Electricity Regulatory Commission a request for suspension of the temporary license for performance of the international electricity trading activity for a 12-month period.

Namely, on 6 November 2024, the applicant was issued the temporary licence for performance of the international electricity trading activity under registration number 05-28-12-302-20/24, for the period from 24 November 2024 until 23 November 2026.

Pursuant to Article 51 paragraph 9 of the Licensing Rule - Consolidated Version, it is the undisputable right of a holder of a licence to request its suspension. Licensees are free to dispose of the right of ceasing the international electricity trading activity in line with their business interest for a specific period of time or permanently, to previously report the intention to use this right to the regulator and obtain a decision to that effect as prescribed in the regulatory rules. In accordance with the mentioned provision of the Rule, the right of the license holder to suspension may be implemented once during the term of the license for a period from six to twelve months.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid as well as the fact that the applicant has not asked for the suspension of the license since its issuance, there has not been any obstacles to pass the decision as stated in the operative part of this decision.

Pursuant to Article 9.2 of the Law on Transmission of Electric Power, Regulator and System Operator of Bosnia and Herzegovina, proceedings may be initiated against this decision before the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina by filing a lawsuit within sixty (60) days of receipt thereof.
