

Pursuant to Article 4.2 of the Law on Transmission of Electric Power, Regulator, and System Operator in Bosnia and Herzegovina (Official Gazette of BiH, 7/02, 13/03, 76/09 and 1/11) and Article 26 of the Tariff Pricing Methodology for services of electricity transmission, operation of ISO and ancillary services – consolidated version (*Official Gazette of BiH*, 93/11 and 61/14), at the session held on 31 October 2016, the State Electricity Regulatory Commission adopted

## **DECISION**

### **ON PROVISION OF MISSING VOLUMES OF ANCILLARY SERVICES FOR NOVEMBER 2016**

#### **I**

The missing volumes of ancillary services for November 2016, which will be provided by the holders of licences/permits pursuant to the obligation under the conditions for performance of the generation activity as defined by the relevant entity regulator and any other entity the technical facilities of which are entered in the Register of Ancillary Service Providers, shall be ensured by this Decision.

#### **II**

Taking into account basically the proposal by the Independent System Operator in Bosnia and Herzegovina presented in the letter No. 1254-1/16 of 21 October 2016, the missing share of secondary control capacity reserve shall be provided as follows:

- Elektroprivreda Hrvatske zajednice Herceg Bosne, Mostar – 4 MW and 7 MW during peak and off-peak hours respectively,
- Elektroprivreda Republike Srpske, Trebinje – 3 MW and 9 MW during peak and off-peak hours respectively.

#### **III**

The price of providing the service of secondary control capacity reserve shall be equal to weighted average prices of offers accepted in public procurement procedures for this service and it amounts to 30.00 BAM/kW/month, with the prices for peak and off-peak hours being 22.50 BAM/kW/month and 7.5 BAM/kW/month respectively.

#### **IV**

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of the adoption and shall be published in the *Official Gazette of BiH*, official gazettes of the entities and Brčko District of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
